



Blue Ridge Neuroscience Electronic Medical Records

Need to easily transport your pertinent medical information? Looking for a convenient method of sharing medical information between the different physicians you see? Sign up for media based medical records. Your medical records will be copied to a credit card sized CD containing an electronic copy of your pertinent medical information. The purpose of electronic medical records is to enable you to have control and possession over your medical information so that a health care provider, unfamiliar with your medical history, would have the necessary information to provide the accurate treatment to you.

How can I get a copy of my medical records?

Simply fill out a request form. You may leave it or send this application form to Blue Ridge Neuroscience Center. Allow 4-6 weeks for shipment of your CD.

How is my medical record CD Made?

The information comes directly from Blue Ridge Neuroscience Center's medical record system.

Are hospitals in all countries equipped to read the CD?

Most medical facilities around the world have basic computers with CD-ROM readers, and can access the information quickly. The information requires only Adobe Acrobat Reader, which is contained on the CD itself, to view your medical records. If Adobe Acrobat Reader is not installed on your computer, click the installation link on the homepage, follow the prompts, and your medical records are ready to be examined.
